Hallo Everyone,

Just to give you an update.

I have been through and made notes on the different types of Plans and the Planning Applications relating to the Police Station and Meudon House ( this will be needed for highways work or part of it will.

Before I compile a note to you on my findings I thought I would sit at the computer and check the Planning Portal for information on the current status of these - nothing new available. There were 54 pages to go through and what a trawl through these realised the numerous applications/preapplications made going back to beginning of 2017. I have made a note of local ones. The reason for this is that they increase the number of people living and working in or around the area designated Civic Quarter. This we should use to highlight the need for the RIBC Indoor Bowling Green and potential for a very much increased membership. One planning application was for 374 units. There were quite a few where Commercial buildings/units were being converted/demolished to provide residential use. One was 115-117 Pinehurst Road which must be close by.

I have sent an email via the PLanning Portal asking for details as to current status of planning applications for the Police Station/Meudon House and Elles House and also for a plan showing the planning permissions/applications and their status for others in and around the Civic Quarter. I had to do this in 500 words - not easy for me! The plan should help us identify how near to the Civic Quarter the developments are and save us walking the streets to make our own plan.

As soon as I get a reply I will probably draft a letter to Ashley Sharpe at RBC I think this may be the time that I have to own up to being a Non-practising Solicitor with Commercial Property experience but I will keep things addressed to Dave.
