Dear Katherine,

I am standing as a candidate for the Liberal Democrats in Knellwood in May, having joined the party in January this year.

As a result I have attended a number of council meetings in recent weeks as an observer in the public gallery.

Last week I was present at a meeting of all the councillors, during which the subject of your bowling club being excluded from inclusion within the new development came up.

Although aware of the redevelopment, this was the first I had heard of this. I was very annoyed, disappointed and aggravated by learning of this fact, and even more so when the relevant portfolio holder did not answer a question put to them by a councillor concerning how the allotted funds to working with your club were / would be spent. Electing, deferring to provide the response privately in writing to the councillor who had asked the question.

Thereby not allowing anyone in the public gallery to know the answer.

At that meeting Alan Hillier, informed me that he had contacted you in December last year about the matter, and that you had invited him to join you at a meeting with members of the Labour Party, and that he had not replied to you regarding this meeting or the questions that you raised re supporting your case to remain in the new sports centre.

He has asked if I would contact you to see if there was anything that you felt the Lib Dems could assist with.

I have taken the time to read all the documents associated with the planning application and those posted on the

bowling clubs web site. So I am fairly up to date with where you are with your appeal and petitioning.

I fully accept that at this late stage that there is probably little more the Lib Dems can do to provide any practical support or assistance to you, and in this regard it seems that the Labour party have been somewhat more helpful in this respect.

Never the less, if there is anything that you feel we could do to support you from this point on, I would like to reassure you that I would personally ensure that every effort would be made to do so.
