

RUSHMOOR INDOOR BOWLING CLUB.

Actions regarding Proposals 4.1 and 4.2 from Special General Meeting held on Friday 28th May 2021

The results of the voting for the distribution of Club funds which SHOULD have been an either/or choice but was sent out erroneously (who checked it then?) as a YES/NO for BOTH as at 21st May 2021 are as follows:-

Of the 79 votes received, voting YES to:-

1. Bowling clubs within the Rushmoor Borough boundaries	45	61.6%
2. Charities	28	38.4%

Whilst a number of members are barred from voting due to the "3 years a member" rule, nevertheless there were 11 votes for both. By eliminating those that voted for both I got:-

1. Bowling clubs within the Rushmoor Borough boundaries	34	66.7.0%
2. Charities	17	33.3%

As you can see in the first case the number of YES votes received to distribute the funds to Bowling clubs does not reach the two thirds majority required by the constitution, which is not good, even though the second one does.

Again, bearing in mind the extraordinary circumstances that we have been operating under we agreed the following as a compromise. Otherwise, we think we would have to call another SGM to resolve this matter alone, which we are not prepared to do

1. Donate approximately 2/3rds of the final sum (about £18000) to the six Rushmoor clubs. Approximately £2000 each making £12000.
2. Donate the balance to the Charities receiving most votes, e.g.:-
 - Phyllis Tuckwell (15 votes) £4000
 - Parkinsons (4 votes) £800
 - British Heart Foundation (2 votes) £400
 - NSPCC (2 votes) £400
 - Macmillan Cancer Research (2 votes) £400

N.B. There are two votes for the committee to use for charities as they see fit!

3. Give what's left over to the committee members to buy a pint as we deserve it.
